

Donna Dunay, FAIA, is an ACSA Distinguished Professor and Professor Emerita of Architecture at Virginia Tech.

Her work explores and illuminates women's contributions to architecture and a cultural and civic understanding of education and practice through design research. She recently served on the AIA Strategic Council, and she also served on the Canberra Accord team to review the National Board of Architectural Accreditation of China. Chair of numerous NAAB accrediting teams, her involvement with architectural education from a national and international perspective has continued throughout her career. One of her many achievements as IAWA chair is the organization of the 18th Congress of the International Union of Femmes Architectes in celebration of the 30th Anniversary of the IAWA in 2015. Her book, Town Architecture: Understanding a Virginia Town and the Center for Civic Activity National Design Competition along with articles, exhibitions, and presentations at national and international events have contributed to multiple communities.
